<p>Addresses that of an ANP with the addition:</p> <p>Sick notes and medicals</p> <p>Pregnancy related problems</p>	<p>Complex / Multiple and On-Going Illnesses</p> <p>Minor Illnesses – new coughs, sore throats, chest infections, etc.</p> <p>Complex contraception</p> <p>Breast Lumps, menopause & women's health</p> <p>Minor Surgery</p> <p>Minor injuries</p> <p>Simple medication reviews</p> <p>Acute asthma and COPD problems</p> <p>New contraception (incl. implant fitting)</p> <p>Sexual health advice</p>	<p>Suspected water / urinal infections/ cystitis</p> <p>Sexual health advice (family planning clinic only)</p> <p>Chronic disease reviews e.g. Asthma, COPD, diabetes, etc.</p> <p>Smears and swabs</p> <p>Contraception / pill checks</p> <p>New dressings and follow ups</p> <p>Some minor ailments (mainly: ear or nose problems, skin issues, nail concerns, rashes and Urinary Tract Infections)</p> <p>Ear and eye infections</p> <p>Vaccinations/ Immunisations</p> <p>Minor Injury (falls, dressing requirements, etc)</p>	<p>Blood tests requested by a GP</p> <p>Blood pressure checks, incl. 24hr monitoring.</p> <p>Basic health checks (all ages) incl. free NHS and new patient checks</p> <p>ECG (heart tracing) incl. 24hr monitor</p> <p>Flu vaccines</p> <p>Coronary Heart Disease reviews.</p> <p>Breathing tests requested by GP</p> <p>Ear syringing.</p> <p>Smoking cessation services.</p> <p>Warfarin (INR) clinics</p>
