**You may be eligible to claim Pension Credit, even if you own your home or have savings.**

**People who claim Pension Credit may also be able to get:**

- ✓ Help with heating costs
- ✓ Help with rent or council tax
- ✓ A free TV licence for those aged 75 or over
- ✓ Help with the cost of NHS services, such as dental treatment, glasses and transport costs for hospital appointments

**You could be eligible for Pension Credit if your weekly income is:**

- ✓ **Single person – below £218.15\***
- ✓ **Living with a partner – below £332.95\***

Benefits such as Attendance Allowance, Disability Allowance, Personal Independence Payment won't be included in calculations when determining whether you're eligible for Pension Credit.#

*\*Qualifying income level may be higher in some circumstances.*
