You may be eligible to claim Pension Credit, even if you own your home or have savings.

People who claim Pension Credit may also be able to get:

- Help with heating costs
- ✓ Help with rent or council tax
- ✓ A free TV licence for those aged 75 or over
- ✓ Help with the cost of NHS services, such as dental treatment, glasses and transport costs for hospital appointments

You could be eligible for Pension Credit if your weekly income is:

- ✓ Single person below £218.15*
- Living with a partner below £332.95*

Benefits such as Attendance Allowance, Disability Allowance, Personal Independence Payment won't be included in calculations when determining whether you're eligible for Pension Credit.#

*Qualifying income level may be higher in some circumstances.
